4122-15 Co-option to Council

Eleven councillors were elected unopposed to twelve seats in the May 2015 election. A vacancy existed which Council must seek to fill. (LGA 1972 s 89, LGA 1972 sch 12 s39)

The Chairman proposed, and it was agreed that previous practice be followed, with co-option at the 25 June meeting, namely: Advertise vacancy – noticeboards, website, word of mouth for decision by parish councillors at June Council meeting.

Potential co-optees, in order of receipt of their application forms (*copies circulated to all councillors*) would have up to 3 minutes in which to present themselves to councillors.

Following all presentations a paper ballot would be undertaken of councillors present. The Clerk would act as 'presiding officer'. Ballot forms would be presented in alphabetical order by surname. Voting by a clear majority vote.

In the event of no clear majority the lowest scoring candidate would be removed from the vote and a subsequent vote undertaken. If two candidates secured the same number of votes there would be a re-vote. In the event of the remaining two candidates having equal votes the Chairman would secure his casting vote.

Votes to be counted by the Clerk and ballot forms retained for 6 months.

It was further noted that in the event that the Parish Council was unable to appoint to fill the vacancy the district council may by order appoint until an election. The order would then sent to the Secretary of State in duplicate (LGA 1972 s91)

The successful candidate would be invited to sign the declaration of acceptance of office, declaration of interests and code of conduct pre council meeting at 7.30pm and so immediately commence as councillor.

4123-15 Power of General Competence

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It was reported that Section 1 of the Localism Act 2011 provides for the General Power of Competence for councils in England and is available to parish and town councils which meet conditions of eligibility for the exercise of the power as set out in the Parish Councils (General Power of Competence) (Prescribed Conditions) Order 2012.

In February 2013 Wheathampstead Parish Council resolved that it met the relevant criteria to exercise this Power which remained extant until this annual meeting, the first after an ordinary election.

The newly formed Council needed to consider the criteria and resolve that it met them in order to retain the power. It was agreed that the criteria were fulfilled:

- 11 of 12 potential councillor vacancies have been elected at the May 2015 election (>2/3 elected)
- The Clerk holds the Cert HE in Local Policy
- The Clerk has received relevant training in the Act subsequent to her Local Policy qualification

Councillor Reason proposed, seconded by Councillor Woodhams, and it was agreed, that Council met the prescribed conditions and was eligible to use the General Power.
