5947-18 Citizens Advice St Albans presentation and grant request

June Chapman, CEO of Citizens Advice St Albans District (CASTAD) gave an informative presentation on the role and outcomes of CASTAD's work in Wheathampstead for the six months from April 2018. She thanked the parish Council for its £4,000 grant which funded the cost of the outreach worker. Wheathampstead was the flagship outreach within the District and it was good to see such promising conclusions to often complex issues.

She spoke also of the plans for a new dementia project, a project worker working in addition to the weekly advisor but with both groups of carers and those living with dementia. This would take the form of individual advice and group sessions.

Councillors asked a number of searching questions, and case non specific responses were given.

To enable CASTAD to budget for the forthcoming financial year they had once again requested that their grant application be considered at budgeting period, this had been submitted and circulated for consideration.

Councillor Habib proposed, seconded by Councillor Davies, and it was agreed, that a grant of $\pounds4,000$ plus use of the Green Room on Thursday mornings be awarded for 2019-20
